

"Being Earthquake Ready in India"

Collective inputs from over 200,000 Citizens in governance circle "Transform India with Modi"

- 1. Earthquake Resistant public places could be built which could be used for people to take shelter in case of an earthquake
- 2. Earthquake alarms should be installed in colonies and in high rises to warn the residents
- 3. The designs of the new buildings should be passed only if they are on an earthquake resistant design
- 4. Inferior quality construction should be checked and banned
- 5. Regular mock drills should be done in densely populated areas to train people in quick evacuation
- 6. Every city must have trained Emergency Response Teams to provide quick turnaround service
- 7. The local circles concept of Emergency Readiness citizen and administration community in every district is a must
- 8. Education of safety during earthquakes should be included in the syllabus of schools
- 9. India should tie up with countries like Japan and understand their processes of handling an earthquake (preparation and response)
- 10. The fire stations should be converted to Safety and Rescue Centre at every 200 kms and locals should be trained on earthquake response
- 11. More focus on Disaster Management at District levels is needed along with interfacing with RWAs, NGOs, Hospitals, etc.
- 12. Every work building, school and RWA should have a disaster recovery plan and mock drills conducted twice a year
- 13. Every Government or Private hospital must have a fully functional Disaster/Emergency ward at all times to continue as an authorized hospital
- 14. Awareness should be spread using television and other forms of media.
